During one of our National Mining Association meetings in the early 80's, one of my friends sent me a book (The Breakthrough Company by Keith R. McFarland). Last week I was purging my library and started to read it again.

The author studied 7,000 companies and narrowed it down to nine that have made the transition to major player status. I want Jennmar to become the tenth! How did Jennmar become the most successful manufacturing company in mining and tunneling? It applied the Business Bermuda Triangle.

Just off the coast of Florida lies a half-million-square-mile portion of the Atlantic Ocean, known as the Bermuda Triangle. The region first made headlines in the 1950's after several airplanes and ships mysteriously vanished there, which fueled rumors of alien abductions, compass-defeating magnetic waves, deep ocean earthquakes, and ship-swallowing pockets of methane gas. When you travel through the area, which connects Miami, the island of Bermuda, and San Juan, Puerto Rico, you do so at your own risk, say wary observers.

Small companies, by virtue of their size, often have three major advantages. As a company grows, it must transform the characteristics that gave it its small-company edge into sustaining advantages. The difficult process of doing this is what we call navigating the Business Bermuda Triangle.

The Business Bermuda Triangle



a. As they grow, companies must find ways to move from dependence on "low-cost, high-performance labor" and low overhead to build structural cost advantages. We call this moving from cost reduction to cost optimization.

b. Companies need to move from a focus on customer recovery to building robust systems that focus on monitoring customer relationships and anticipating customer needs.

c. Companies must build speed and responsiveness into the very structure of their firms as they grow and become more complex.

Throughout my 55 years in the mining industry everybody in the company has contributed to these interactions of becoming a successful company. This includes hourly, salaried, truckers, clerks and upper management. I desire that these attributes be followed in the future so that I can claim that tenth spot!

GRAND OPENING OF HARNESS PRO AUSTRALIA

Harness Pro Australia manufactures a wide range of customized and OEM replacement electrical harnesses that are braided with a high tensile, multifilament coating which provides superior protection for the underlying wires from external abrasion and environmental factors. Harness Pro Australia design and manufacture "ready to install products" used in heavy equipment for the mining, earthmoving, agriculture and marine industries.

JENNMAR COMMITS TO GSSO RESEARCH PROJECT PHASE 2

Jennmar has again committed to the Australian Centre for Geomechanics (ACG) Ground Support Systems Optimisation (GSSO) Project through sponsorship of phase 2 of the project. Jennmar was a key sponsor of the original phase 1 project which was commenced in 2013. GSSO is an international research project focusing on ground support systems optimisation, funded by industry and the Minerals Research Institute of Western Australia.

Phase 1 of the project explored methods and options to optimise ground support systems, with the aim to maintain, if not improve, mine safety whilst reducing costs and/or time components. The overall objective of GSSO Phase 2 will be to develop new tools and guidelines for ground support design in extreme ground conditions (more specifically in rockbursting and squeezing ground) and advancing the use of probabilistic approaches in mining geomechanics.

RECIPE CORNER

BACON-CHEDDAR RANCH CHICKEN AND POTATOES

INGREDIENTS:

1/4 cup ranch dressing

6 large bone-in, skinless chicken thighs (1-3/4 lb.)

4 slices bacon

1-1/2 lb. red potatoes (about 5), cut into 1-inch chunks

1 onion, cut into 1/2-inch chunks

1 cup cheddar cheese

2 Tbsp. chopped fresh parsley

DIRECTIONS:

Pour dressing over chicken in shallow dish. Refrigerate 30 min. to marinate.

Heat oven to 400°F. Cook bacon in large skillet on medium heat until crisp. Remove bacon from skillet, reserving 1 Tbsp. drippings in skillet. Drain bacon on paper towels.

Add potatoes and onions to reserved drippings; cook 5 min., stirring occasionally. Remove from heat. Crumble bacon. Add to potato mixture; mix lightly. Spoon into 13x9-inch baking dish. Remove chicken from marinade; discard marinade. Place chicken over potato mixture. Bake 55 min. to 1 hour or until potatoes are tender and chicken is done (165°F). Top with cheese and parsley.
